Scholarships

- **Federation Excellence Scholarship** valued at 20% of the annual tuition fee. Applicable for international students applying for undergraduate or postgraduate courses (not a study abroad, exchange or online student) and commencing in 2024. Minimum GPA of at least 5 during the study period
- **Federation Pathways Scholarship** valued at 20% of the annual tuition fees of a pathway course such as Foundation or Higher Education Diploma. Applicable for international students eligible to study in Australia with a valid visa and commencing studies in 2024.
- **International Student Accommodation Support Scholarship** valued at \$1000 per semester for two semesters (total annual value \$2000 AUD). Applicable to international students commencing studies in 2024 and living in university accommodation. Students should not be a recipient of a Destination Australia Scholarship.
