




LEEDS BECKETT UNIVERSITY

January 2025 intake deadlines:

- Application deadline: 30 November 2024
- CAS deadline: 13 December 2024
- Turnaround time: 4–5 days



Deposit details:

- To receive Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) in Leeds Beckett University, 50% of tuition fees should be paid as a deposit.

Tuition fees

- UG: £16,000/year
- PG: £17,000



Mandatory documents

1. CBSE, ICSE: 70%

UG Entry Requirements

- 60% from CBSE, ICSE or a recognized State Board

PG Entry Requirements

- Minimum 2.5 GPA or Second class honours degree from a recognized university is required
- Minimum 50% or above in degree is required

English language requirements:

- IELTS 6.0 (min 5.5)
- PTE 54 (min 51)
- TOEFL 79-89 (R18, L17, S20, W17)



Scholarships

- For undergraduates: £1,000/year
- For postgraduates: £3,000 (first year only)
