Nepal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Higher Secondary School Certificate, with grades over 55% in year 12</li> <li>• Mathematics (if applicable to your course) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Higher Secondary School Certificate with 55% in year 10</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4-point scale or grade B in a bachelor's degree when studied for a minimum of four years.</li> </ul>
Sri Lanka	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student required to complete A Levels. For students undertaking A levels, the required A level scores are listed in each undergraduate course listing.</li> <li>• Mathematics (if applicable to your course) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– GCE O-level Mathematics. C grade, or 50% pass or above</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A completed Special Degree (normally four years long) from a recognised institution. Grade B, or 55%, or a 2:2 classification or above</li> </ul>
Nigeria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• WAEC SSCE with an International Foundation year</li> <li>• Ordinary National Diploma (OND) with at least a lower credit</li> <li>• Students who have completed Year 1 (Level 100) of a Nigerian university can be considered for Year 1 entry to a bachelor's degree.</li> <li>• An NCE (National Certificate of Education) from a college of education is also acceptable for entry into Year 1 only.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Bachelor's degree – 2.2</b></p> <p>Applicants with third class degrees from a recognised Nigerian university are welcome to apply for postgraduate courses if they meet the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A minimum of three years full-time relevant work experience after National Youth Service Corp (NYSC) or</li> <li>• Further professional qualification and two years post NYSC</li> </ul>
