Entry Requirements

- Undergraduate – A bachelor's degree is essential for many careers and a prerequisite for a master's, typically taking 3–4 years full-time.
- PG– A master's by coursework takes 18–24 months full-time, with a focus on coursework and a thesis or major project in the final stage. Many offer specialisations.

English Language Requirements:

Students must provide evidence for their English language skills, if they have:

- Completed an English language test such as IELTS, Pearson, or Cambridge.
- Completed some types of university (tertiary) or high school (secondary) studies.
- Completed an approved English subject in IB Diploma, Australian Year 12 or other high school qualifications.
- Lived and worked in an English-speaking country for at least five years.

Scholarship Opportunities:

GAP Restrictions:

- A gap of up to 18 months (UG and PG) from the date of application is acceptable.

Key Co-op Courses (UG & PG) Points:
